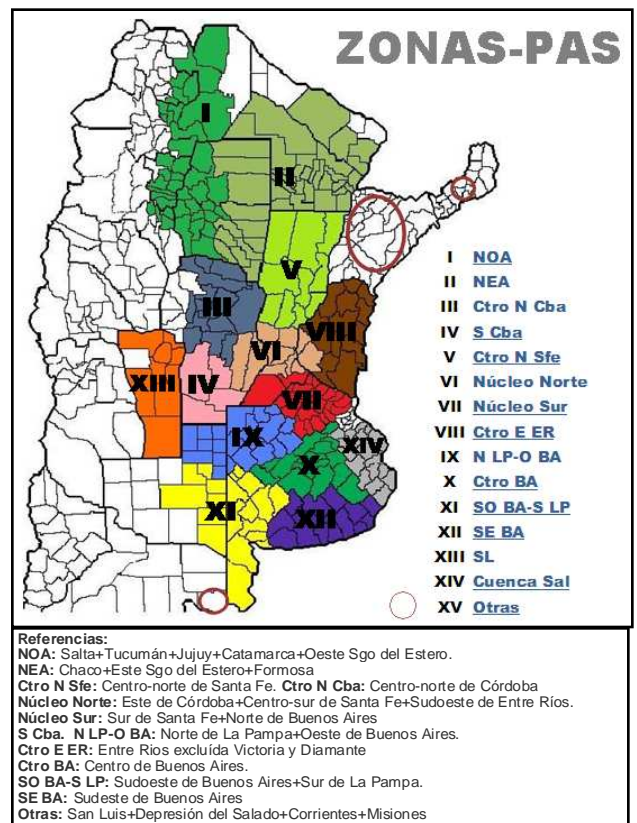

CROP REPORT - HIGHLIGHTS

CORN

Fieldwork is delayed due to weekend rains and soil temperatures.

Rainfalls, the prospects that generate the values of the grain, the need to include the poaceae in the rotations and last year's record yields would boost an increase in the area used for commercial grain. The new projection would be of 2.930.000 hectares, 11.6% higher than the previous campaign.

The Niña effect is still raising concerns among producers of marginal areas. Rains forecasted in great part of the humid pampas, would help define leasing and start fieldwork.

WHEAT

Updated reports adjusted the planted area in 4.27 million hectares (previous 4.20 million).

Last weekend rains improved the crops conditions in Santa Fe, Entre Ríos, East of Cordoba, and Northeast, Mid-East, West, Southwest and Southeast of Buenos Aires. However, lack of precipitations still affects Cordoba, Southern Buenos Aires, Salta and Tucuman.

New rains are forecasted for this weekend in great part of the agricultural region of la Pampa, leading to the strengthening the cereal.

SUNFLOWER

After last week's rains, fieldwork was fostered in the northeast of the country and north-central Santa Fe. As from last Monday, producers have carried out fieldwork in those plots destined to sunflower.

At a national level, more than 132 thousand hectares have been planted. This corresponds to 8.7% of the surface projected in 1.52 million hectares. Weekly progress stands at 2.9%.

In Entre Rios, fieldwork is still performed in specific plots. After rainfalls, la Pampa and the Southwestern of Buenos Aires improved their perspectives. New rains prior to fieldwork are awaited to increase their planting prospects.
